Minutes

The business meeting was called to order by President Les Fullerton at 10:18 AM.

President Fullerton welcomed members and guests. He informed the group of the time constraints for the meeting room and made a brief introduction of the Clayton Library Friends (CLF) Executive Board members. President Fullerton subsequently introduced Liz Hicks to speak about the Angel Program.

Mrs. Hicks spoke to the group regarding the need for volunteers on Wednesdays in the Clayton House. She mentioned that the volunteer may also work on his or her own genealogy during a shift, as it is rarely busy in the Clayton House. Mrs. Hicks also noted that there is still a need for "Angels" to sponsor the 2016 Angel periodical subscription program.
